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Beaverhead County Sheriff's Office Identifies Victim in Fatal Fall at Clark Canyon Reservoir

The Beaverhead County Sheriff's Office has released additional information regarding the death of a man whose body was discovered on an island at Clark Canyon Reservoir on July 30, concluding that the incident was an accidental fatal fall.

According to the Sheriff's Office, deputies responded to a report of a deceased male located on the island at the popular recreation area.

First responders, including personnel from Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks (FWP) and the Beaverhead County Sheriff's Office, located the body of a young adult male on a rocky section of shoreline directly below a well-known cliff diving location.

Investigators observed minor injuries, abrasions, and small marks on the victim. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Following an investigation, authorities found no indication or evidence of foul play.

The victim has been identified as 25-year-old Dawson Roylance.

Roylance's body was transported to the Montana State Crime Lab in Missoula, where an autopsy was conducted. According to the Sheriff's Office, the medical examiner determined his injuries were consistent with a fall from an elevated height.

The Beaverhead County Sheriff's Office extended its condolences to Roylance's family and friends.

"The Beaverhead County Sheriff's Office extends its sincere condolences to the family and friends of Dawson Roylance during this difficult time," the agency said in a statement.

Safety Reminder for Cliff Divers

The Sheriff's Office is also reminding the public that cliff diving at Clark Canyon Reservoir and other recreation areas can be extremely dangerous.

Officials noted that changing water levels, shallow water, submerged rocks and other hazards, as well as unstable cliff edges, can quickly create life-threatening conditions.

Anyone choosing to participate in cliff jumping or cliff diving is encouraged to use extreme caution, be aware of changing conditions, and understand the risks before entering the water.

The investigation into the incident has been completed, and authorities have determined the death to be the result of an accidental fall.

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**Driver Escapes Injury After Ford Bronco Leaves

A driver escaped injury Tuesday afternoon after a Ford Bronco left the roadway and came to rest in Big Sheep Creek approximately 11 miles up Big Sheep Creek Road southwest of Dillon.

The crash was reported at approximately 2:30 p.m.

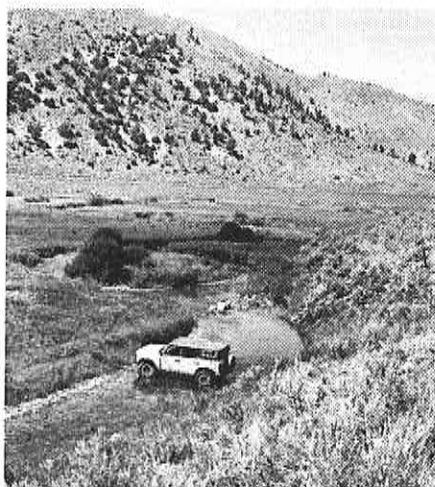
According to information from the scene, the Ford Bronco was traveling along Big Sheep Creek Road when the driver failed to negotiate a curve. The vehicle slid off the roadway, traveled down an embankment, and came to rest in the creek below.

The Bronco did not roll over, and the driver was not injured in the crash.

Deputies with the Beaverhead County Sheriff's Office and troopers from the Montana Highway Patrol responded to investigate the incident.

The cause of the crash has not been released, and no citations or additional information were immediately available.

Motorists traveling on rural mountain roads are reminded to use caution, particularly on winding stretches where curves, loose gravel, and changing road conditions can increase the risk of leaving the roadway.

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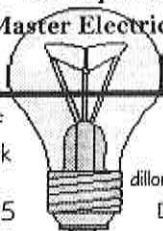

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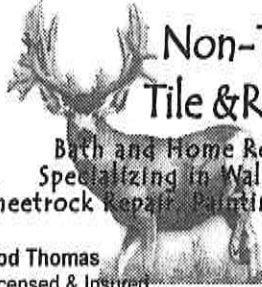

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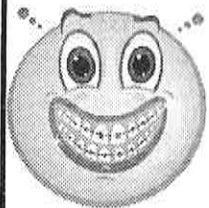
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Fishing restrictions added to more areas of lower Beaverhead River

More areas of the lower Beaverhead River will be under daily fishing restrictions this week due to rising water temperatures.

These restrictions, commonly known as hoot-owl restrictions, prohibit fishing from 2 p.m. to midnight each day. They are designed to prevent excessive fish mortality due to angling when water temperatures are warm.

Beginning Aug. 5, a hoot-owl restriction will be in effect for the area of the Beaverhead River from Selway Park Fishing Access Site just north of Dillon to the confluence with the Big Hole River. This expands a restriction already in effect for portions of the lower Beaverhead River.

FWP's drought policy provides for angling restrictions when flows drop below critical levels for fish, when water quality is diminished, or when maximum daily water temperatures reach at least 73 degrees for three consecutive days. In cutthroat trout waters, angling restrictions occur when the temperatures reach at least 66 degrees for three consecutive days. Water temperatures of 77 degrees or more can be lethal to trout.

Catch-and-release anglers can reduce stress on fish by getting them to the net or in hand quickly, keeping them in the water and reviving them prior to releasing them back into the river. As the summer warms, Montana offers many other angling options with better conditions for fish, including larger lakers or reservoirs or higher-elevation lakes and streams. FWP also monitors stream flows and, in some streams, holds instream flow water rights.

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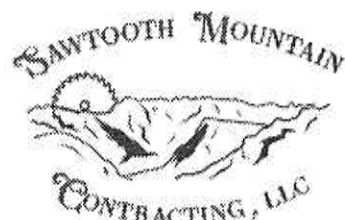
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Thank You, Dillon

A special thank you goes to Dallas Osburn and the crew at Osburn Fence and Fabrication for taking our plans and making sure everything stayed on schedule. Because of their efforts, not only were we able to host the State Tournament, but the Beaverhead County High School baseball team was also able to finish its successful season with home games on the field.

This season, 28 young men wanted to wear a Dillon Cubs uniform and represent their community alongside their friends. With 28 players, we were able to field two teams and even organize games specifically for younger Dillon Middle School players who weren't yet eligible to play at the high school level. Providing opportunities for young athletes to develop their love for the game is something we're very proud of.

The Cubs organization works hard every year to keep costs affordable for our players and families. One of the biggest reasons we're able to do that is the tremendous support we receive from our local businesses through sign sponsorships, donations, and our annual raffle ticket sales.

I can honestly say there wasn't a better burger served at any ballpark we visited this summer, and their generosity helped keep concession costs affordable while supporting the Cubs.

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Another exciting step forward this season was being able to livestream every home game. Thanks to Mike Clarke's research and the support of Air Grids in upgrading our internet service, family, friends, and Cubs fans who couldn't make it to the ballpark were still able to follow the team all summer long. It was a tremendous addition to our program. If you haven't had a chance to watch, every 2026 Dillon Cubs game is still available on GameChanger.

A special thank you also goes out to KDBM/KBEV for broadcasting our home games on the radio so fans could stay connected wherever they were, and to Southwestern Montana News and the Dillon Tribune for their outstanding coverage of all our home games and the incredible photos they provided throughout the season. Your support helps tell the story of our team and our community in a way that means so much to the players and families.

While our win-loss record may not have reflected all of the progress we made, this team accomplished some remarkable things. Early in June, we traveled to Burley, Idaho, and captured the annual Wood Bat Tournament championship, highlighted by a 4-1 victory over the host Green Sox, who would later become Idaho State Champions.

We also earned impressive wins over Belgrade, the eventual Montana State Champions, 12-8, and the Gallatin Valley Outlaws, 9-8, our first victory over them in five years. At the State Tournament, we opened by upsetting the Bitterroot Red Sox, who entered the tournament riding a 23-game winning streak, with a thrilling 4-3 victory.

More important than any individual win was watching this group grow throughout the summer. The boys were playing their best baseball at the end of the season, and while it was difficult to see it come to an end, I can honestly say every player improved, every player contributed, and every player helped shape the success of this year's team. I couldn't be more excited to see what next season has in store.

It doesn't seem that long ago that what we now call home was little more than gopher mounds, bare dirt, and weeds. Since the Cubs and the City of Dillon partnered to make Ray Lynch Field our home in 2013, the transformation has been incredible—not only for the Cubs field, but also for Beaverhead Little League's new complex. The future is even brighter, with plans already underway to construct a third field and expand the infield on the field closest to the Cubs so it can accommodate all levels of baseball and softball. Those improvements will allow us to host even more teams and tournaments while continuing to grow the game in our community.

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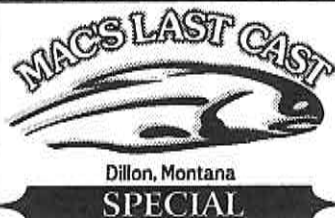


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Veteran's Corner Update #576
